Biography

Kerry Scullion is senior counsel and manager of the Criminal Conviction Review Group, created by the Department of Justice, Canada, to review and investigate wrongful conviction applications.

He obtained his Masters of Criminology (1977), his LL.L (1983) and his LL.B (1984) from the University of Ottawa. He was called to the Ontario Bar in 1986.

Mr. Scullion worked with the Law firm of Bayne, Sellar and Boxall for five years, then in private practice as a criminal lawyer for four years.

In 1995 he joined a government oversight agency of the Correctional Services of Canada, the Office of the Correctional Investigator of Canada, as an investigator. In 1997 he became Counsel and Coordinator of the Legal Training Department of Correctional Services Canada, moving in 2003 to his current position with the Criminal Conviction Review Group.
